Advice to patients prior to placement of implants

- Have something light to eat prior to your appointment.
- Wear loose fitting clothes and be prepared to remove a few layers as it can get warm under the surgical drapes.
- 3. Please arrive a few minutes early for your appointment so we can confirm final details.
- 4. Have a supply of analgesics (painkillers) and mouthwash present at home as some discomfort can be expected after a surgical procedure.
- 5. Do not plan any important events for a few days following the procedure as some mild to moderate swelling may be expected which is part of the normal healing process.
- 6. Antibiotics if prescribed should be taken one hour prior to your appointment.
- . 7. Any anxieties you may have are easily remedied. Sedation may be appropriate which can be administered by our qualified in house staff.
- Please bring along your consent form so we can discuss any additional queries you may have.

Recommended- Analgesics- Ibuprofen Paracetamol

Mouthwash- Chlorhexidine (Corsodyl)
